

Pilot Name: opengov Leader: GFOSS Involved Partners: UNIS, CERTH, KT, IK, UNIVDUN


- 15 years of operation as Greece's official deliberation platform
- Track record: 1,174 deliberations, 383,250 comments, 28 public bodies
- Critical role in legislative process: mandatory for all draft laws
- Current WordPress-based implementation (open source)
- Established moderation and reporting processes

Current Situation-Technical Challenge Definition

- Manual comment moderation bottleneck
- Difficulty in synthesizing large volumes of feedback
- Time-consuming summary report creation
- Lack of argument analysis capabilities
- Resource-intensive quality control





opengov Pilot_ Overview

Current Situation-Institutional Challenge Definition

- Extent the duration of deliberations (currently only 2 weeks)
- Extent the scope beyond draft laws to include critical economic and social decisions
- Align with EU and OECD best practices



opengov Pilot_ Overview

Needed AI Features:

- Comment analysis to speed up moderation
- Comment clustering summarization to speed up report generation
- Argument extraction for insight gathering
- Documentation tools for comments acceptance in the final law
- Good participation assistance tool for citizens



opengov Pilot_ Overview

Envisioned Impact of AI4Deliberation to Pilot

Quantitative Outcomes:

- . Reduced moderation time by ...%
- . Speed up report generation
- . Increased comment processing capacity
- . Higher participation rates

Qualitative Impact:

- . Better organized feedback (even when deliberation is still open)
- . More insightful summary reports
- . Improved trust in the quality of deliberation (as perceived by stakeholders)
- . Enhanced citizen engagement
- . More evidence-based policy making




- Platform expertise

- First Sprint (M7-M12)
- GFOSS Action Plan
- Extract and prepare historical deliberation data for analysis
- Define requirements for AI feature integration
- Provide domain expertise on moderation processes
- Coordinate stakeholder input from public sector administrators


• What is needed from partners (M7-M12)

- Design WordPress plugin architecture
- Develop initial integration framework

Al Services

- Design API specifications for comment clustering
- Create prototype for basic summarization
- Setup AI service infrastructure
- Develop testing methodology for AI features
